Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of Minutes: Councilman Paige made a motion to approve the minutes of July 6, 2020 as presented. Councilwoman Sharpe seconded with all in favor.

Ord. #20-05: This ordinance, rezoning property of Williams Investment Company located along Alabama Road from GB to R-8, was read for the 2nd time. Councilman Greene made a motion to approve the ordinance. Councilwoman Sharpe provided the second. The decision was unanimous.
