<u>Approval of Minutes</u>: Councilman Paige made a motion to approve the minutes of August 2, 2021 as presented. Councilwoman Sharpe seconded with all in favor.

Ord #21-03: This ordinance, rezoning property of J. Santos Gutierrez located on Washington Post Rd. from GB (General Business) to R8M (Residential), was read for the second time. Councilman Paige made a motion to approve the rezoning request. Councilman McClain seconded with members Cowart and Greene voting in favor. Councilwoman Sharpe cast the only opposing vote.

Intergovernmental Agreement on Communications Tower (CDBG-MIT): As part of the grant requirements for the communications tower that will be built off of Honeymoon Lane, city manager John Flythe presented an IGA to the council that we must have with the County. This agreement is being presented at their meeting tonight for approval. It was noted the State has a 45-day turn around for having this in place.
