

Virtual Council Meeting
December 21, 2020

Members Present: Mayor Buddy Duke, members Terry McClain, Greg Paige, Walter Cowart, Vivian Sharpe and Jody Greene.

Others Present: John Flythe, Rhonda Rowe, Tim Tanner, and a member of the public.

Invocation was given by Councilman McClain.

Pledge of Allegiance

Moment of Silence: Mayor Duke held a moment of silence in honor of past Mayor Richard Barr, who passed away on Sunday. City Manager John Flythe recommended flying the flag at half-mast until Mr. Barr's funeral. City attorney Tim Tanner advised we would need to get approval from the governor's office.

Approval of Minutes: Councilman McClain made a motion to approve the minutes of December 7, 2020 as presented. Councilwoman Sharpe seconded with all in favor.

Alcohol License Renewal: Councilwoman Sharpe made a motion to approve the renewal application submitted by Eshal & Annaya, LLC located at 1003 W. 4th Street. Councilman McClain seconded. The decision was unanimous.

Res. #20-11: This resolution, authorizing the execution of the lease documents under GMA's direct leasing program for two vehicles purchased for the police department, was presented to the council. Councilman Cowart made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilman Greene seconded. All were in favor.
