

Council Meeting
January 5, 2015

Members Present: Mayor Richard C. Barr, members Jody Greene, Chandler Hill, Buddy Duke, Greg Paige and Butch Fausett.

Others Present: John Flythe, Rhonda Rowe, Tim Tanner, Chad Castleberry, Larry White and members of the public.

Invocation was given by Councilman Fausett.

Approval of Minutes: Councilman Fausett made a motion to approve the minutes of December 15, 2014 as presented. Councilman Hill seconded. All were in favor.

Appointment of Mayor Pro-tem: Following with the rotation by chair, Councilman Paige made a motion to appoint Councilman Duke as Mayor Pro-tem for 2015. Councilman Fausett seconded. The decision was unanimous. Both Mayor Barr and Councilman Duke expressed their appreciation to Councilman Paige for his service during 2014.

Alcohol License Renewals: Councilman Duke made a motion to find 4 applications qualified for renewal based upon the information submitted. Councilman Fausett seconded. There was no opposition.

Resolution #15-01 (Alabama Road Extension): This resolution, acknowledging the need for relocating and paving an extension of Alabama Road, acknowledging the need for the construction of drainage channel improvements, and authorizing the city manager to proceed with advertising/acceptance of such bids and entering into contract upon Walmart's purchase closing, was presented to the council. Councilman Fausett made a motion to adopt the resolution. Councilman Greene seconded. The decision was unanimous.

Mediacom Rate Increase: The council was advised of the receipt of information from Mediacom concerning rate adjustments being implemented on January 15th.

Meeting Date Change: Due to the next regular meeting occurring on Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday, Councilman Fausett made a motion to reschedule the meeting for Tuesday, January 20, 2015. Councilman Hill seconded. All were in favor.

Other Comments:

City Manager John Flythe recognized Larry White who was in the audience and is filling in for Public Works Supt. Wayne Giddens during his absence due to illness.

Mayor Barr expressed his appreciation for everyone's concern and help during his recent recuperation period from sickness.
