

Council Meeting
January 19, 2016

Members Present: Mayor Buddy Duke, members Butch Fausett, Greg Paige, Michael Purvis, Chandler Hill and Jody Greene.

Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of Minutes: Councilman Fausett made a motion to approve the minutes of January 4, 2016 as presented. Councilman Purvis seconded. All were in favor.

Swearing-In of Elected Officials: City attorney Tim Tanner administered the oath of office to re-elected officials, Mayor Buddy Duke and Council Members Butch Fausett and Greg Paige.

Appointment of Mayor Pro-tem: In following the rotation of chairs, Councilman Paige made a motion to appoint Councilman Jody Greene as the Mayor Pro-tem for 2016. Councilman Hill seconded. The decision was unanimous.

Swa-car Bids: Bids were received for two (2) 23 cubic yard sanitation trailers and were as follows:

Councilman Greene made a motion to accept the low bid from Cook County Welding. Councilman Fausett seconded. There were no opposing votes.

Alcohol License Renewal: Councilman Fausett made a motion to approve the license renewal of Blue 42 Sports Grille, LLC. Councilman Purvis seconded. All were in favor
