October 17, 2016

Members Present: Mayor Buddy Duke, members Butch Fausett, Greg Paige, Michael Purvis and Jody Greene.

Others Present: John Flythe, Rhonda Rowe, Tim Tanner, Chad Castleberry and members of the public.

Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of Minutes: Councilman Purvis made a motion to approve the minutes of September 26, 2016 as presented. Councilman Paige seconded. All were in favor.

Transformer Bids (Electric Dept): Bids were received for a 300 KVA transformer and were as follows:

Councilman Purvis made a motion to accept the low bid followed by a second from Councilman Greene. The decision was unanimous.

Blarney Cup Chili Cook-off: The council was advised of the 1st Annual Chili Cook-Off to be held by the Blarney Cup.

Street Sign Request: Kathi Tillman had requested, but did not appear, to be on the agenda to request that portion of the road at the east end of 1st Street that had previously been closed to the public to have a street sign with the designation of "Caldwell Way". It was noted this was now a private road and Councilman Greene questioned if there could be issues with 911 if it were to be designated with a different name instead of 1st Street. After a discussion with the city attorney and questioning by Councilman Purvis if the property owners were purchasing the sign, or if they expected the city to, it was the opinion of the council that this sign needs to look differently than our normal street name signs and the individuals would need to make the purchase since it is for their private property.

Veterans Flag Request: The City of Adel has been asked by the Vietnam Veterans Group for help in digging a hole for a Veteran's flag that will be placed on property belonging to the funeral home located at 207 E. Mitchell Street. City manager John Flythe stated since this was on private property, he had requested and received confirmation the City of Adel would have no liability. The council concurred to assist this group.

Sewer System Camera: City Manager John Flythe informed the council we had received quotes on a couple different camera systems and would talk about the differences in the cameras at the next meeting.

Electrical Service Contract: The city manager advised the council we have continued to be in negotiations with the prospect that has been discussed over the last couple months. After all attorneys have agreed to a final contract proposal, it will be brought back before the council for their review and approval.

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned.
